

Memorandum to correct error in the article
on Chief Justice Fuller in the "Green Bag" for January 1889

- ① Rev Thomas Weld - First minister of Roxbury -
Was graduated at Trinity College, Cambridge Eng, 1613
Was minister at Terling, Essex Co. 38 miles from London
in 1631
Was ~~st~~ communicated by Archbishop Laud at
that time Bishop of London -
Came over in the "William & Francis" arrived at
Boston Nov. 5, 1632. Was settled at Roxbury July 1632
His children born in England were
John, 1625; Thomas 1626 Samuel 1629
and Edmund born in America July 8, 1631
- ② Thomas Weld, son of Rev Thomas Weld,
was born in England - 1626.
~~Admitted~~ Admitted fellow in Roxbury 1654
Married June 1650 Dorothy - daughter of
Rev. Samuel Whiting of Lynn -
Nothing said in Wether's Hist of Acquetta
about his being a minister - (probably ~~did not~~)
or of his living in Dedham
- ③ Rev Thomas Weld son of the above was born June 12, 1653
settled in Barnstable
First wife was Elizabeth Palmer^m June 9, 1681
second wife was Mary Darnley
He died June 9, 1702
His son Hatijah was born Sept 2, 1702
nearly eight weeks after his father's death
Hatijah Weld son of the above
married Mary Fox - daughter of
Rev John Fox
Hatijah Weld's daughter Hannah
married Caleb Fuller Over

Thomas Fuller } married Hannah Flower
of Dedham Mass } Feb 23. 1643

Thomas Fuller } married Esther Fisher
son of the above } 1687
was born June 23 1662 }
(she had a brother Daniel, also)

Esther Fisher was the daughter
of the persecuted patriot, Daniel Fisher
and sister to Daniel Fisher who
seized the person of Sir E. Andros

Rev. Daniel Fuller } married Lucy Goodrich
son of the above } Aug 7
was born in Dedham Apr 20 } 1723

Rev. Caleb Fuller } married Hannah Weld
graduated }
Yale 1758

H. W. Fuller son of the above } married Esther Gould
was born July 1. 1784 }
named Hadiyah Weld Fuller }
name changed to Henry Weld Fuller

J. A. Fuller son of the above } married Catherine Martin Weston
