Louis Brandeis's place in the history books would be certain even had he never joined the Supreme Court. Consider the "Brandeis brief" in *Muller v. Oregon* and his other work as "the people's lawyer"; his services to Zionism; his influence on the Woodrow Wilson and FDR presidential administrations; and his writings, such as *The Right to Privacy, The Curse of Bigness*, and, of course, his contributions to the *Green Bag.
